Living a sanctified life is possible. Perfection is not only possible to God and Angels but to us also.

Matthew 5:48 KJV, “Be ye therefore perfect, even as your Father which is in heaven is perfect.”

Matthew 26:41 KJV, “Watch and pray, that ye enter not into temptation: the spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak.”

We cannot be sanctified except we pray, Romans 8:13 KJV, “For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live.”

It's dwelling in the Word that brings sanctification. Righteousness means following the steps of Christ, following the examples of Jesus, not just that you must not steal.

Requirements For Sanctification

1. Hunger Or Thirst And Love For Righteousness – Do not give in to the tradition of men. Matthew 5:6 KJV, “Blessed are they which do hunger and thirst after righteousness: for they shall be filled.”

2. Engagement With Godly Association - You are not going to be different in the next 20 years except for the books you read and the friendships you keep. 1 Corinthians 15:33 KJV, “Be not deceived: evil communications corrupt good manners.” Living a sanctified life is not rocket science but doing things right.
