

GOD'S WORD DELIVERS

A Message delivered By **Pastor Faith Oyedepo** on Thursday Chapel Service, November 27, 2014

Texts:

"He sent his word, and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions" (Psalms 107: 20).

"For the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart" (Hebrews 4:12).

"Open my eyes, that I may behold wondrous things out of your law." (Psalms 119:18),

"Who also has made us able ministers of the new covenant; not of the letter, but of the spirit: for the letter kills, but the spirit gives life" (2Corinthians 3:6).

"It is the spirit that gives life; the flesh profits nothing: the words that I speak unto you, they are spirit, and they are life" (John 6:63).

"Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust"-(2Peter 1:4).

From the above scriptures, we discover that the Word of God is the master key of life. God's Word cannot be restricted. It has access to our life when we allow it.

The Word of God determines our ultimate worth in life. That is the value placed on the Word that determines your value in life.

The Word of God delivers and sets free.

"He sent a man before them,

Joseph, who was sold as a slave.

“They afflicted his feet with fetters,

He himself was laid in irons;

“Until the time that his word came to pass,

The word of the LORD tested him.

“The king sent and released him,

The ruler of peoples, and set him free.

“He made him lord of his house

And ruler over all his possessions.”(Psalm 105: 17-21)

The Word of God sets free. It has the capacity to dislodge evil spirits (Luke 4: 24-26).

The Word of God has the rule over darkness, and darkness connotes everything that is evil, unholy, etc.

“And the light shineth in darkness; and the darkness comprehended it not.”(John1:5)

How to access the deliverance power in the Word

1. Through the study of the Word of God.

(2 Timothy 2:15)

You need to study the Word consistently. It washes away everything that is not of God.

2. Mediate on the Word of God

(1 Timothy 4: 15)

Think on the word of God.

3. Intense prayer

(Luke 18:1; Matthew 6:5, 7)

You need to pray in the Spirit by praying in tongues

(Jude 1:20)

When you pray in the Spirit you are being strengthened and the devil is shut out of your conversation with God.

4. Engage in spiritual warfare.

(2 Corinthians 10:4, Ephesians 6:11)

No one else can engage in spiritual warfare for you. Therefore, rise up to the occasion.
