**Message: Wisdom from Above Makes High Fliers (Part 2) – Genesis 41: 38 - 44**

Without wisdom man will be stranded on earth; without wisdom, struggling will become the order of the day. Where the wisdom of God is lacking reproach will become the order of the day. Wisdom is a vital requirement for riding the waves of God's glory (Pro. 3 vs. 35; 1 Cor. 2 vs. 7).

Psalm 19 vs. 7 – 9; Psalm 119 vs. 97 – 100 – The word of God is the wisdom of God in print (John 1 vs. 1 – 3; 1 Cor. 1 vs. 24 - 25). The wisdom from the pages of the scriptures is very superior to every other kind of wisdom (2 Cor. 13 vs. 8; Isaiah 55 vs. 9 - 11).

When the wisdom of God is put to work it turns ordinary men into celebrity (James 3 vs. 17). Wisdom is the resourceful application of knowledge. Wisdom is knowing what to do, what productive steps to take next, that will result in the beautification of destiny.

**HOW DOES GOD'S WORD MAKE WISE?** It is important to know that the word of God is God. It is God's word that projects His personality and always generates impact (2 Tim. 3 vs. 15).

1. God's word makes wise through a studious lifestyle. It helps us to rub minds with the only wise God. The word of God is the foundation that helps a destiny find full expression. There is always something to show when the word of God starts ruling and dominating a man's lifestyle (2 Tim. 2 vs. 15; 1 Tim. 4 vs. 13; 2 Cor. 3 vs. 18; Dan. 9 vs. 2; Pro. 1 vs. 5).

Receiving God's word, meditating on it and putting it to work is the easiest way to contact the wisdom that makes great (Deut. 4 vs. 5 – 6; Deut. 6 vs. 3; Matt. 7 vs. 24 - 25). This order of wisdom will always disarm the pit of hell anytime and any day; it engenders success in any area of endeavour (Pro. 24 vs. 3 - 5). Wisdom from heaven is the commander of success: the depth of wisdom at work is the determinant of the level of success one will experience (Deut. 28 vs. 1; Job 32 vs. 8; Gal. 5 vs. 25).

Walking in the spirit guarantees success; walking in the demands and the dictates of the Holy Spirit guarantees good success. As much as God is concerned about man's spirituality, He is also interested in man's total wellbeing. In everything a man does in life, walking in the spirit is key to a profitable living (1 Cor. 2 vs. 15 - 16).

Matt. 28 vs. 20; John 14 vs. 16: The spirit of God is always with the redeemed, but it takes engaging Him for it to manifest its ministry. The Holy Spirit is a personality that can relate with man if the desire for the relationship is there.

2. The Holy Spirit is the living teacher (John 14 vs. 26). Another part of His ministry is the unveiling of secrets and bringing to remembrance of the believer things that he or she may have study at the point of need. What you don't study, the Holy Spirit cannot bring to remembrance.

2 Tim. 1 vs. 17; 2 Sam 5 vs. 19, 23: Always seek the next step to take if you must make the most of destiny. Depend on Him (Holy Spirit); don't operate under the influence of assumption. The Holy Spirit is always there for the believer; all that is needed is for a desperate cry to be made and He will show up. Be patient with the Holy Spirit; don't make any rash decision (Pro. 3 vs. 5 - 6).
