Message: Wisdom from Above Makes High Fliers (Part 4)

There is always a longing in the heart of God's Apostles to bless God's people from time to time (Romans 1 vs. 11).

The wisdom from above is above all kinds of wisdom; the wisdom that created the world that is still intact today, is worthy of all attention. It is important to note that every child of God has this heritage of wisdom from God (Matthew 11 vs. 19) because like begets like. When we become God's children, we become partaker of His DNA. This wisdom is superior to any other wisdom. It helps the believer to know what to do, what step to take, how to take them and when to take them, and it command results after the order of God.

The dominance of heavenly wisdom is the God factor, which is a big factor in the school of wisdom. This provides solutions to all questions of human existence (Genesis 41 vs. 15 – 16). God's wisdom does not stress people, but it refreshes them (Proverbs 3 vs. 16 – 17; Daniel 2 vs. 30, 46). This wisdom is not intellectual competition, but draws its strength from the God of heaven.

To ignore the God factor is to be utterly limited; the God factor is the de facto (Job 1 vs. 1 – 3; Job 29 vs. 4). The secrets of God are with them that fear Him. This kind of wisdom covers all spheres of human life and existence; the supremacy of God's wisdom is incontestable. Divine wisdom solves all problems.

God's word is the custodian of all wisdom (Luke 11 vs. 49; Job 28 vs. 27 – 28; 2 Timothy 3 vs. 15). God's word makes wise; it is God's wisdom bank packaged into the bible (Psalm 19 vs. 7 - 8). The closer you are to the Bible the closer you are to the forces of wisdom, and the farther you are from the Bible the farther you are from the light of wisdom.

Seeking God now at an early stage is vital to living a life of dominion and glory at all time. Developing a craving and thirst for God is key to making the most of the walk of destiny.

However, it takes meditation to tap into the virtues and nutrients in the word that makes room for triumphant living (1 Timothy 4 vs. 14 -15). The place of divine wisdom is that it does not only impart upon one's professional life, but it also impart upon issues of life that human wisdom cannot fathom and uncover.

Engaging the word with the obedience of faith is the easiest way to apply wisdom to commanding supernatural results (Matthew 7 vs. 24). Supernatural restoration is always at the instance of encounter with the revealed word that is appropriated in faith. It is putting the word to work that equals wisdom, and it is this wisdom that makes high fliers (Daniel 12 vs. 3).
