

Exploring The Biblical Laws Of Success

The word of God is God. In this kingdom, what you don't understand will not work for you. Success means the accomplishment of a goal, making satisfactory progress or good outcome of an undertaking, (Mathew 5:13-16).

A law is a principle whose violation must result in a penalty, failure, injury, loss or pain. We have spiritual laws and we have natural laws. Spiritual laws can nullify or set aside natural laws. The love of God in the heart of man is the anchor law of success, (Mathew 22:35-40).

For instance in Genesis 39:9, Joseph the lover of God chose to obey God. David in 1 Samuel 13:14, was described as a man after God's heart. If you are operating in disobedience you are looking for trouble, according to God's word; King Saul was a good example of the effects of disobedience.

Job was also a man who loved God and God restored him, (Job 1:1-3; Job 13:15; Job 29:3-18). Daniel was also a man who loved God and God distinguished him in a strange land, (Daniel 1:8; Daniel 1:17). You can't claim to love God and be operating in sin. You can't love God and not succeed. You can't love God and not make it in life. Shedrack, Meshack and Abednego were great examples of men who loved God and refused to bow to any other God. God rescued them from the fire. The love of God will always bring enthronement, (Deuteronomy 26:1; Romans 13:8).

How Love Enthrones

- It gives you access to God's nature. When you operate in love you manifest His presence. You can't operate in love and fail in life, (1 John 4:8).
- Love establishes companionship with God. This imparts a level of confidence that will enthrone you in life, (Amos 3:3; 1 John 4:16; Isaiah 45:1).

- If God be for us every good thing follows us, (Genesis 39:5,21; Romans 8:31).
- When we walk with God we contact His wisdom that makes us shine as stars.
(Proverbs 13:20; Romans 11:33; Daniel 12:3).
- When we keep company with God, every impossible gate will lift up their heads,
(Psalm 24:8).

The Law Of Supernatural Empowerment

When you are supernaturally empowered success at a high frequency becomes possible. You are 'engraced' to do the seemingly impossible, (Zechariah 4:1-6; Luke 4:14-18). The anointing breaks barriers and empowers for exploits, (Isaiah 45:1; Isaiah 61:1-4).
