Theme: Understanding the Master Key to a World of Exploits (Part 1)

Understanding is what commands and injects life into the affairs of a believer (Psalm 119 vs. 144). When a believer is devoid of understanding, he is, scripturally, in the congregation of the dead (Proverbs 21 vs. 16).

It is understanding that imparts wisdom (Proverbs 4 vs. 7; Proverbs 10 vs. 23), and wisdom is the precursor of exploits. It is by the light of the word of God that any believer commands exploit (Isaiah 60 vs. 1 – 3, 8, 22).

The discovery of one's destiny from the Bible is key to actualising destiny (Genesis 13 vs. 14 – 15; James 1 vs. 25; 1 Corinthians 2 vs. 9 – 10; John 14 vs. 12). The world is in the dispensation of the Holy Spirit, and man cannot go too far in life without the enablement of the Holy Spirit (John 16 vs. 7 – 8/12 - 13).

PATHWAYS TO SPIRITUAL UNDERSTANDING

1. One must be born again (John 3 vs. 3).
2. One must engage in prayer and fasting for understanding: This is where humility plays a vital role, because the individual comes to term with the fact that he or she cannot determine the way to go (Psalm 119 vs. 18; Jeremiah 33 vs. 3; Isaiah 58 vs. 8/10; 2 Corinthians 4 vs. 3 – 4; Matthew 17 vs. 21). The god of this world can only be dislodged through prayer and fasting (Colossians 1 vs. 9; Ephesians 1 vs. 18; Philippians 3 vs. 10; 2 Corinthians 11 vs. 27; 2 Corinthians 12 vs. 7; 2 Peter 3 vs. 15 - 16).
3. One must engage the blood of Jesus against every blindfolding powers of the devil (Matthew 27 vs. 49 – 51; Isaiah 25 vs. 6 – 8).

PROOFS OF EXISTENCE OF SPIRITUAL UNDERSTANDING

- ❖ Spiritual understanding engenders all round rest (Hebrews 4 vs. 9 - 12).
- ❖ It always culminate in outstanding feats (Genesis 41 vs. 38 – 44; Daniel 2 vs. 28).

HOW DO WE ENGAGE GOD'S WORD FOR EXPLOITS?

1. Look out for relevant materials in your area of interest (Daniel 9 vs. 2; 1 Timothy 4 vs. 13 – 15; 2 Timothy 4 vs. 13).
2. Reach out to those who have attain your desired breakthroughs to boost your faith in taking delivery of your expectations (Jeremiah 6 vs. 16 – 17; Hebrews 6 vs. 14).
3. Give yourself wholly to what you have discovered by putting them to work. It is what you do with what you have discovered that determines the outcome of your life.
