A great coach does not make a great player, but each player must take responsibility for his or her greatness. When thanksgiving comes from man, God delights in it (Psalm 22:3). God lives inside our praise.

When God comes down every opposition bows and every mountain is levelled. Our expectations from God is enough reason to give Him thanks. When we give Him thanks, we draw the breakthroughs that are ahead of us closer (Luke 17:11-17).
