Message: Prayer: A Platform for Accessing Supernatural Intelligence

There is no impossible case with God and anything at variance with God's word should be discarded and treated as falsehood – Psalm 100:3; Psalm 139:14. Academically, science has shown that man has not really maximized the full potentials of his brain, and the human brain has been designed to last a thousand years. Yet the most successful man has only used 1 percent of his brain.

The best way to make the most of the potentials inherent in the human brain is by engaging the supernatural. Engaging the supernatural here means using the brain, by the inspiration of God, through the movement of the Holy Spirit on the mental faculty of man – Job 32:8. Without the God factor, there is a limit to which man can accomplish anything.

BIBLICAL PERSONALITIES WHO ENJOYED SUPERNATURAL INSPIRATION

1. Isaac: It was the inspiration of God that enabled Isaac cultivate in the midst of famine and emerged prosperous – Gen. 26: 12 – 15.
2. Jacob: It was supernatural wisdom at work in him that made him ran an affluent husbandry – Gen. 30: 37 – 39.
3. Daniel: The man through the inspiration of the Spirit of God was found with an excellent spirit, which made him relevant in the land of Babylon for a very long time – Dan. 1: 17 – 20.

People with extraordinary results are men and women who operate under the influence of supernatural inspiration. Spending quality time in God's presence is vital to impacting and affecting one's world positively. Anything removing you from God's presence is your greatest enemy, and relationship with God empowers to proffer solutions to challenges facing mankind.

HOW TO CONNECT TO HEAVENLY INSPIRATION

1. You must be born again. The spirit of intelligence cannot operate in an unregenerated mind.
2. Through the revelation from God's word – John 6:36, 2 Cor. 3:18
3. By the dimension of spirit-filled praise – Psalm 119:164. Without joy, it is impossible to be inspired.
4. By reading anointed and inspirational literary materials – Pro. 27:27
5. Through the mystery of prayer and fasting – Isaiah 58:6
