

Unveiling the Breakthrough Power of Vision – Part 2

What God says to one, He says to all (Romans 8:29-30; Job 34:21). He has a plan for you and your future is in His plan (Proverbs 29:18). Wisdom, therefore, is to identify the plan of God for you and follow it.

You are not an accident; God brought you here for a purpose (Jeremiah 29:11). As it concerns all areas of your life, if it is not good, it is not God. You are redeemed to reign on the earth (Revelation 5:9-10). God Has a great opinion of you, do not belittle yourself; you are designed to manifest Gods glory on earth (1 Peter 2:9). You are called to glory and virtue (2 Peter 1:3).

It is very clear that every believer is a star (Job 12:3; John 14:12). We are made to manifest God on the earth (Revelation 22:16); John 17:18). Your sense of value, however, determines the flow of virtue to you. You have to value what God values.

Engaging the Power of Faith in Pursuit of Vision

Every vision is delivered on the platform of faith (Luke 1:45). Faith is obeying God to prove that you believe Him, thereby activating His power on your behalf. “They that observe lying vanities forsake their own mercy,” Jonah 2:8.

Faith is a spiritual weapon. It has the capacity to rewrite anyone's vision, (Isaiah 55:1; 1 Kings 8:15). Faith comes by insight in the word (Acts 8:26-35). When understanding comes, your faith is ignited. Our level of spiritual understanding determines our level of faith (Mathew 13:23). Spiritual understanding means insight or revelation

Channels of Spiritual Understanding

- The Holy Spirit - He is the one that gives understanding (John 14:22-23; John 16:13)
- Through Anointed Ministers - they are light bearers and in their light we see light. But without humility you can't access the realms of such light (Ephesians 3:8-9).
- Through Anointed Books - The kind that Daniel read. “In the first year of his reign I Daniel understood by books the number of the years, whereof the word of the LORD came to Jeremiah the prophet, that he

would accomplish seventy years in the desolations of Jerusalem,” Daniel 9:2. Readers are leaders (2 Timothy 4:13).

- Through Prayers - Psalm 119:18; Jeremiah 33:3.
