Theme: Exploring Biblical Laws of Success (Part 3)

Message: The Law of Skill

Success at extraordinary frequency is the kingdom and redemptive right of the redeemed in Christ. God has destined the redeemed for all round success (Matthew 5 vs. 13 - 14). The redeemed has been wired up to proffer solutions to problems affecting mankind, and the love of God in the heart of man is the anchor law for biblical success (Matthew 22 vs. 35 - 39; Job 13 vs. 15; Daniel 1 vs. 17).

WHAT IS SKILL?

It is the ability to do something well, and deliver the same satisfactorily. To every trade in life there is a required trade skill, and the skill level will determine the level of output (Proverbs 22 vs. 29). One's worth in his or her area of endeavor will always demand updated skills.

These skills can be acquired formally or informally. An individual's skill level is what will enhance his value anywhere, anytime, and it will command attention from around the world to the tiniest corner where he resides and does his business.

Skills can be naturally endowed as deposited by God in man at creation. It can also be acquired through informal training (Genesis 14 vs. 14; 1 Samuel 22 vs. 2 - 3; 2 Samuel 23 vs. 8; 1 Samuel 16 vs. 18; Psalm 94 vs. 10; 1 Kings 4 vs. 29 - 34).

When God created man, he gave him skill(s), and God is committed to seeing that such skill(s) find full expression in the life of that man (Psalm 78 vs. 70 - 72). Failure to make the most of the skill(s) deposit in you, will lead to a frustrated life and result in failure to fulfill destiny (Exodus 35 vs. 30 - 34).

THE BLESSEDNESS OF SKILLS

No purpose has a future without skills. Each time a man discover the rich deposit in him, it results in extraordinary accomplishment. The deposit in man is always begging for expression at all times.
