Your future is in locating His plan and abiding in it (Mark 4:11).

It may delay, but it cannot be denied. He took His people through the wilderness so they can develop capacity for endurance (Exodus 13:17).

Vision requires patience and endurance, because you are appraised by your stamina and stability. Do not allow yourself to be distracted and drawn away from your vision and purpose. You must deliberately live to be responsible. Stop liaising yourself with wrong people in the name of friendship. Friendship is not by force, it's by choice. Show me your friend and I will show you your character.

You must determine the quality of your life by taking responsibility early. If you don't sit up today, you won't stand out tomorrow.

Make sure you are adding value. Nobody can sack value. You can't sustain what you did not earn.

Nothing that belongs to you works itself out, you must work out God's plan for your life as a matter of personal responsibility (Philippians 2:12-13).

If you don't pursue anything, you can't possess it, because pursuit is the proof of desire. You have to work God's plan out; settle down and work so you don't lose value. Your value is in your work.

Take responsibility today and you'll never end up a liability tomorrow.
